

# Navajo Nation OSHA – Education Training Training Request Form

The courses cover OSHA Standards, regulations, rules and procedures in General Industry (1910) and Construction Industry (1926). Topics include scope and application of the OSHA Standards, Safety and Health Principles, specialist emphasis on the most hazardous conditions. In each course completion, students will have the ability to define general industry and construction industry terms found in the OSHA Standards, identify hazards which may occur in either industries, able to locate and determine appropriate OSHA regulations, policies & procedures and describe the use of the OSHA Standards and regulations to supplement an ongoing safety and health program. NNOSHA training classes are available at workplaces, based on scheduling with class size of at least 10 students. NNOSHA requires 5 or more participants to conduct training.
